ORDINANCE NUMBER - 1989 - 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TAX CERTIFICATIONS BY THE DULY ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR, SETTING THE COSTS AND FEES FOR THE SAME AND ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE TAX COLLECTOR RELATIVE TO THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: From and after January 1, 1990, the duly elected Tax Collector of the Borough of West Newton shall provide, upon request, a written statement, certified by him or her, of the taxes and/or assessments collectible by the Tax Collector which remain due and owing for each taxable or property in the Borough.

SECTION 2: The fee for such tax certification shall be the sum of FIVE AND NO/CENTS (\$5.00) DOLLARS, which fee shall be paid to the Tax Collector at the time of the request.

SECTION 3: The Tax Collector shall remit to the Treasurer of the Borough, on or before the tenth day of each and every month, all sums collected by him or her for the preceding calendar month for such tax certifications, along with a statement identifying the name of the

requesting party, the party or taxable involved, the date of the request and certification and the sum charged and collected.

SECTION 4: The Tax Collector shall be compensated on a monthly basis for the issuance of such tax certifications in an amount equal to the amount collected by the Tax Collector and remitted to the Borough Treasurer for such tax certifications. Said compensation shall be paid to the Tax Collector on or before the 20th day of the month for the preceding calendar month.

SECTION 5: The compensation paid to the Tax Collector for such certifications shall be in addition to the other compensation due and payable to the Tax Collector for the collection of Borough taxes and assessments.

SECTION 6: Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance is, and the same are, hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: If any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, unlawful or invalid, such decision shall not effect the constitutionality, legality or validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Council of the Borough of West Newton declares that it would have passed this ordinance or any one or more remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or

phrases be declared unconstitutional, unlawful or invalid.

SECTION 8: This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1990.
