ORDINANCE NO. 1988- 4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF MEMBER  
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE WEST NEWTON BOROUGH POLICE PENSION FUND  
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1989

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 9 of West Newton Borough Ordinance Number 1980-1, as amended, and further based on a letter submitted by Mockenhaupt, Mockenhaupt, Cowden & Parks, Inc. to the effect that the latest state mandated actuarial study indicates that the elimination of member contributions for the calendar year, 1989, will not adversely affect the actuarial soundness of the West Newton Borough Police Pension Fund, the member contributions into the West Newton Borough Police Pension Fund by participating officers for the calendar year, 1989; are hereby eliminated.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect for all time worked by the participating officers subsequent to December 31, 1988.

SECTION 3: That any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance be, and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
